

Minutes of the Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting for Underbarrow & Bradleyfield held by ZOOM at 7pm on Thursday 20th May 2021.

The Chairman (Councillor Ben Cunliffe) welcomed everyone to the meeting.

There were five in attendance, including three Parish Councillors, District Councillor John Holmes and Parish Clerk Kevin Price. Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Charlotte Cartwright, Sylvia Gibson and Mark Simpson.

Minutes:

The minutes of the 2019 Assembly Meeting held on 22nd May 2019 were taken as read. There were no matters arising.

Chairman's Report:

The Chairman gave a brief verbal report. It had been difficult year due to the pandemic and all meetings had been held by ZOOM, apart from a brief open air meeting to sign off the accounts in July. Longstanding problems include the repair of the mushroom on Scout Scar and the condition of the roads in the parish, especially the potholes at Dobby Lane and area. The Council had kept up its usual pattern of meetings, mostly every two months. The Chairman thanked all the Councillors for their work and attendance, including the County and District Councillors and the Parish Clerk.

District Councillor's Report:

Councillor Holmes had circulated a full report and this will be appended to these minutes in the file.

Any other business:

Mushroom on Scout Scar: The repairs have not yet been carried out; it is proving extremely difficult to find anyone local who will deal with it, despite there being adequate funding in the 'Scout Scar' account. The Council continues to receive comments from members of the public about this and recently Kendal Town Council was in touch with this Council about the problem.
